## **AMAG: Major contract with Constantia Flexibles**

- **Major multi-year contract signed**
- **A minimum of 35,000 tonnes of aluminium coils to be delivered annually**
- **Closed loop recycling for sustainable carbon footprint**

On April 28 2017, AMAG signed a multi-year contract with flexible packaging manufacturer, Constantia Flexibles, for, a minimum of 35,000 tonnes of aluminium coils to be delivered annually to Constantia's Teich facility in Weinburg, Lower Austria. Teich is the production site for packaging foils for food, pet food and pharmaceuticals. This contract represents a continuation of a 20-plus year business relationship, and is based in no small part on the expansion of AMAG's product range, made possible by the plant investments in Ranshofen. At roughly 16 percent, packaging products have a significant share in the overall sales of the AMAG rolling mill.
